ORDER

The above matter came on before the undersigned on April 11, 2016:

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2015, the Court entered Scheduling Order No. 2 ordering that “[i]f a plaintiff selected as a bellwether plaintiff (whether for discovery or trial) voluntarily dismisses its case, Syngenta may identify a replacement within five (5) days thereafter”;

WHEREAS, on December 22, 2015, the Court entered an Order selecting forty (40) bellwether discovery plaintiffs;


WHEREAS, on April 6, 2016, bellwether discovery plaintiff Smith Feeder Supply, Inc. (Non-producer) voluntarily dismissed its claims with prejudice and by Order of April 11, 2016, the Court approved the dismissal;

WHEREAS, counsel for Syngenta has notified counsel for plaintiffs of its replacement bellwether discovery plaintiff: Van Tilburg Farms, Inc. (Non-producer), in accordance with the process outlined in the parties’ February 22, 2016 letter to the Special Master that the Court incorporated by reference in its March 1, 2016 Order regarding bellwether replacements; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby ordered that:

1. Plaintiff Van Tilburg Farms, Inc. (Non-producer) is selected as a bellwether discovery plaintiff to replace plaintiff Smith Feeder Supply, Inc. (Non-producer).
